It's the perfect time of year to tackle those weeds. During the early spring season, it is best to spray pre-emergent weed killer to tackle the weeds before you see them. If you're already seeing weeds pop up in your lawn, you'll want to look for a post-emergent herbicide. HomeGuides.com advises: For the best results, gardeners should time the weed killer application to take place before weed seeds start to germinate, generally in the early spring. Gardeners often reapply the weed killer approximately eight weeks after the first spraying to help with exceptionally invasive weeds, such as crabarass.

The StoneyBrooke HOA would like to give residents a checklist to help them review their properties for compliance with the HOA's guidelines and avoid any violation letters.

- Lawn maintenance: lawns shall be mowed, trimmed, fertilized, and watered as needed.
- Weeds: lawns, landscaped areas, and flower beds shall be free of weeds.
- Landscape maintenance: flowerbeds, trees, and shrubs on your property should be maintained.
- Shrubbery: all shrubs and bushes must be regularly trimmed to a reasonable height and shall not excessively block windows or patios.
- Mailboxes: all mailboxes, poles, and mailbox numbers shall be painted/replaced if rusted or damaged.
- Trash cans: trash cans should not be visible from the street and should be out of sight except on trash pick-up days.
- Signage: no signage of any kind is allowed in StoneyBrooke, including political, advertising, or business signs.

Please contact the office with any questions or concerns. We appreciate your help! Remember, any external changes or improvements must be submitted through the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) process first. This includes cutting down trees, or changes in your landscaping.
